**High School Report:** “Meet the Mustangs” had a good turnout, that plus donations helped complete fundraising for a new Marquee sign. A \$20,000 deposit and order has been sent to Yesco, who sent the cheapest bid. Tomorrow the School Board will finalize details before posting 3 high school job openings. They will be posted by the end of the week. The HS is hoping for 2 full time teachers to replace Ralph Perkins & Lane LeFevre, Teresa Thompson. Susan (librarian?) is assisting kids who need reading help in HS. Board needs feedback on whether the TSSA workers (JoAnn Savage, Jen Prince, Cindy Barney) are effective in targeting help for students at risk and passing on data about their progress.

**Elementary Report:** Parents and committee members can voice to Board members the need for the Elementary Principal job to be posted as a full-time position. Emails can be submitted to Mr. Savage whose address is on Board Docs. Teresa Decio and Lesa Ahlstrom plan to attend. April LeFevre has suggested that board meetings be moved to 5pm to better accommodate parents and teachers attending. The Elementary is desperate for Paraeducators and Volunteers. We will post on Facebook to raise awareness of the need. Funds are increasing for next year. Partly due to lack of Paras, Elementary will have about \$8,000 left over. Teachers will discuss trainings and other ideas to effectively use funds. BVE will get protective covers over exterior glass to prevent further shattering of windows. BVE Dedication was a great success! In March there will be a Utah Pioneers Program. BVE considering buying outdoor storage container for PE equipment. Mrs. Zeyer (K) moving. Mrs. Simper and Mortensen also considering retiring. Shayne Implementing “Burst” and guided reading which are helping raise Assessment scores.
